Dear Parent / Guardian,

It is with great excitement that Year 7 students at Foxwell State Secondary College will have the privilege to view a performance of “The Stones” by Shock Therapy Productions as part of their Positive Education and Enrich programs. This performance will be viewed in their Enrich curriculum time in Week 4 on Wednesday 28th October.

The play “The Stones” is about risk taking behaviour and the pain of guilt when things go too far. It places the audience in the position of a jury where they must consider whether the characters are responsible for their actions. This is such an honour for our students to engage with this educational piece.

Activity details:

Week 4 Wednesday 28th October

- Students will meet their Enrich teacher at their regular timetabled classroom. Teacher will mark the roll and students will proceed to the sports hall with their bags. They are to be seated by 2pm.
- Students will view the performance “The Stones” by Sam Foster and Hayden Jones of Shock Therapy Productions which runs for approximately 55 minutes.
- Students are expected to uphold the appropriate behaviour standards of Foxwell SSC by being actively engaged and involved in all aspects of the performance.
- When the students finish watching the show, there will be a short Question & Answer session. Students will be able to ask questions about the performance, acting, staging and themes if they would like to know more information from the actors.
- Students will be dismissed at 3pm.
